General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

The GDPR applies in all EU member states from 25 May 2018. It is the result of four years of work by the EU to bring data protection legislation into line with new, previously unforeseen ways that data is now used.

Individuals have a right to be informed about how St Joseph's Catholic Primary School uses any personal data that we hold about them. We comply with this right by providing 'privacy notices' to individuals where we are processing their personal data. These privacy notices explain how we collect, store and use personal data about pupils, parents, staff and all those involved in our School.

To ensure that St Joseph's is compliant with the new regulations, we have been updating Privacy Notices, Policy and Consent Forms. The revised Consent Forms have been sent home this week and need to be returned by Friday 22nd June. The revised Policy and Privacy Notices can be found on the school website under Statutory Information.

Due to these new regulations we can no longer issue parents with the names of pupils in their children's class for party invitations.
