<p>What is Sports Premium?</p> <p>The government has provided funding of £150 million per annum to primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport. Each school receives £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil aged from 5 to 11. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in school.</p>
