For each child who is eligible for free school meals the school receives additional funding. This funding can then be used to subsidise his/her trips and lessons, therefore making you a saving. If you are in receipt of any of the following, apply by going to:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400)
- Income Support (IS).
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBSJA).
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA).
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income that does not exceed £16,190).
- Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment you get for a further 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).

Children who receive a qualifying benefit in their own right can also get free school meals.
