


More recently, St Joseph's have increased their attendance at events where they have also experienced success.

COVID UPDATE: Advice to Parents - warn and inform

The full letter is posted on ClassDojo.

We have been advised by UKHSA that there has been confirmed cases of COVID-19 within the school setting.

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are providing the following advice.

Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

The school setting remains open and your child should continue to attend as normal if they remain well.

We encourage household members that are aged 11 and over to continue with twice weekly LFD testing to help identify cases promptly.

If you think your child is a close contact but has not been contacted directly by NHS Test and Trace then they should take a PCR test.

Please do not send your child to school if they are displaying Covid symptoms.

If your child receives free school meals

If you didn't previously qualify for free school meals, but your income has recently reduced or stopped, please apply online through DCC website or call the education helpline on 0345 155 1019 to check if you are eligible for this support as soon as possible, and before Friday 17 December, in order to receive the holiday vouchers for the Christmas holiday.

PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS



If your child was born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018 they will be due to start at primary school from September 2022.

You will be able to apply for a primary school place between 15 November 2021 and 15 January 2022.

You will be able to apply online using the Citizen's Portal. If you do this the local authority will notify you of the outcome of your application by email on 19 April 2022. This is the most preferable way to make an application.

THE ROWCROFT RUDOLPH RUN WEDNESDAY 15TH DECEMBER




