

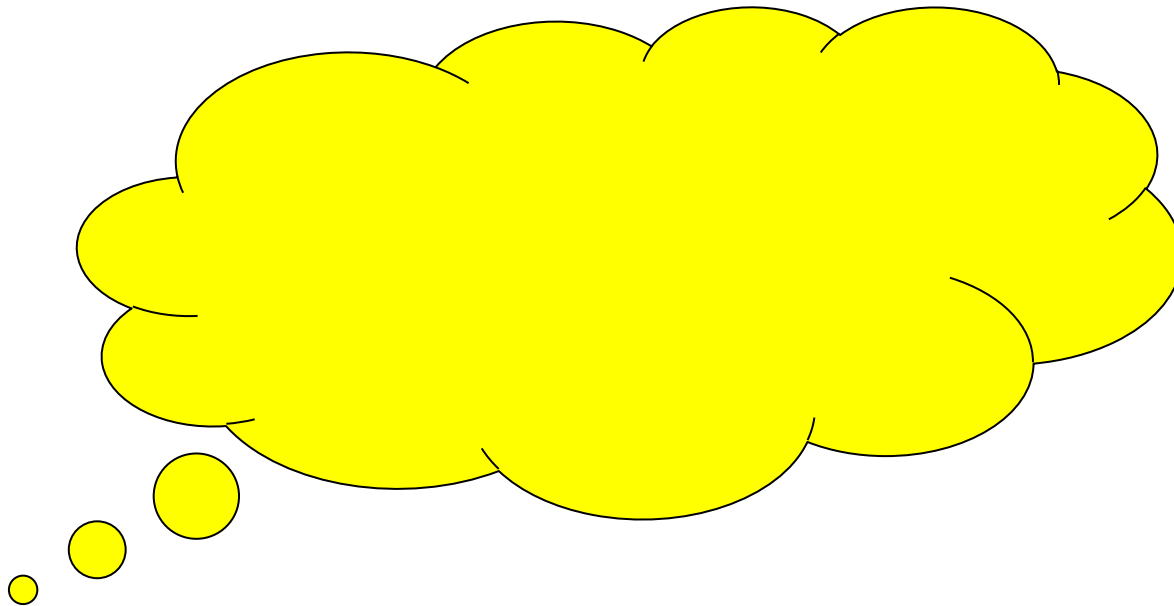

1. Gentle reminder stating inappropriate behaviour.
2. Yellow card given as a warning (Five minutes standing off/ to the side of the playground)
3. Red card (sent to the Headteacher or Senior Teacher)
