ANNUAL REPORTS

Annual reports to parents will go home on Friday 28th June. The following abbreviations are used to show a child's attainment and progress.

Attainment grades and language	What this means
B-ARE (Below Age Related Expectation)	Your child is working below the standard for their year group.
W-ARE (Within Age Related Expectation)	Your child is working within the objectives for their year group.
ARE (Age Related Expectation)	Your child is working securely within the objectives for their year group.
GD (Greater Depth)	Your child has achieved at least 80% of the objectives for the year group and is applying their knowledge in more depth.
Progress Grades	What this means
A	Your child has made greater than expected progress.
B	Your child has made expected progress.
C	Your child has made less progress than we would expect.
Effort Grades	What this means
A	Fantastic approach to all areas of work. Exceptional attitude shown consistently.
B	Good approach to all areas of work and regularly demonstrates a positive work ethic.
C	Inconsistent approach to work. Focus and determination need to be improved.

CALM TOOLS for FAMILIES

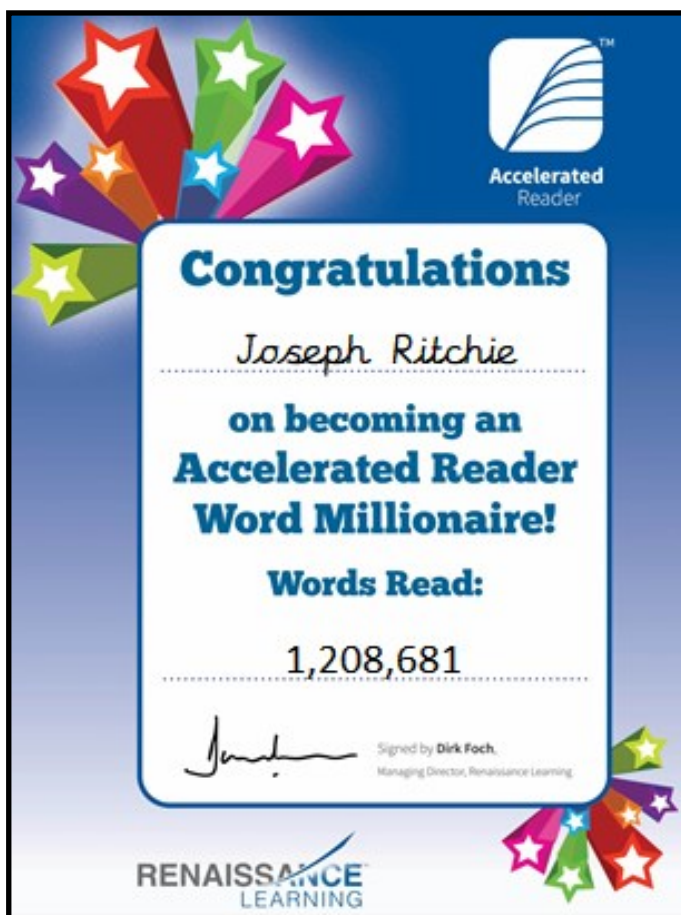

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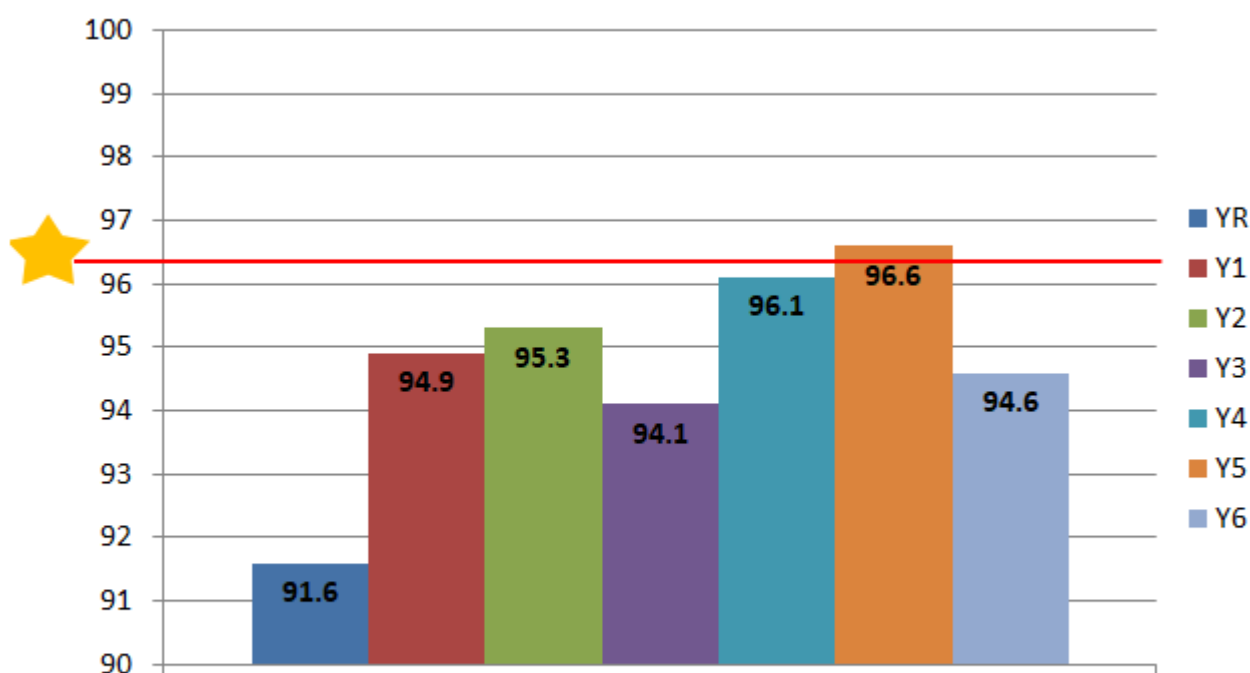
