Dear Parents/ Carers,

Re: Coronavirus update – school closure to most pupils

Following on from my last update, I'm now writing to let you know that we have now been instructed to close the school to almost all children after this Friday until further notice. As advised by the government, we will do all we can to stay open for the children of key workers and children with certain needs. (Children with a named social worker or with an Educational, Health, Care Plan.)

We are waiting for the government to publish more information on what this means, but it would help us in the meantime if you could let us know if you think your child may fall into one of these categories.

Please email admin@sjna.uk or Class Dojo to Sarah Hobart **by 4 pm** today if you think your child may fall into one of these categories and with answers to the three points below.

1. Category your child falls into
2. Whether your child will need school term time access
3. Whether your child will need child care during the Easter holiday.

We'll be in touch again as soon as we are sure who this does apply to and when we have established whether we have enough staff to remain open for the child care required.

All other children will need to stay at home, so we ask that you do not send your child into school from Monday onwards. Your child's learning is of course important to us, so we'll continue to help your child to learn and details of how this will work will be sent home tomorrow.

Please note that this is a national closure – as you may have heard in the news – so while it is a challenging situation, we are not alone. We'll re-open fully as soon as we can and will let you know when this is by sending a Dojo to all parents and publishing the information on our school website.

If your child usually receives free school meals we will also be in touch with more information about how we will continue to provide this, with support from a scheme that the government has just announced.

This is as much as we know right now and we appreciate your continued patience with as we deal with this ever-changing situation. We understand that this latest news will have an impact on you and your family and it's far from ideal, but we'll continue to keep in touch with any updates as the situation develops.
