It's hard to believe that in this day and age, there

are children who do not have a warm and comfy bed to sleep in every night. In fact, one in five children living in the south west are living in poverty, and in parts of the region poverty is even more severe. Some areas in our Diocese actually fall into the top 10% of the most deprived areas in England.



As part of our Good Shepherd programme, this Christmas The Catholic Children's Society (Plymouth) is asking children living in our Diocese to think of children less fortunate than themselves by putting themselves in their shoes just for one night. We are asking children living in Devon, Cornwall and parts of Dorset to give up their bed for one night to sleep on the floor.

Please ensure that the Supplementary Form (available from the school office) for this school is returned to the school office by 15th January 2021. Without this form your child may be lower in the priorities for admission and risk not getting a place at St Joseph's School.
